The Government of Sierra Leone through the Ministry of Transport and Aviation has received funds from the International Development Association for the Procurement of Equipment for Bus Monitoring Control Centre under the Sierra Leone Integrated and Resilient Urban Mobility Project and now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders. The Project Fiduciary Management Unit, an implementing agency of the Client, intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this (Grant) to eligible payments under the contract for which this Request for Bid is issued. The Project Fiduciary Management Unit (PFMU) now invite sealed Bids from eligible bidders who can demonstrate Technical and Financial Capabilities for the Procurement of Equipment for Bus Monitoring Control Centre.

2. Bidders shall quote for all items as required in the Bid Document. Bids will be evaluated and contract will be awarded to the Bidder meeting the required qualification criteria.

3. Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the National Public Procurement Act 2016 and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers July 2016 Revised November 2017, August 2018 and November, 2020.

5. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amounts indicated above or its equivalent in a freely convertible currency. The Bidder shall seal the original and each copy of the bid, in separate envelopes, duly marking the envelopes as “**ORIGINAL (1)**” and “**COPY (3)**.” The envelopes shall then be enclosed in an outer envelope and sealed.

6. Interested bidders may obtain further information and inspect the bidding document at the address below between office hours 09:00 to 17:00 hour. Bidding documents may be purchased upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Two Thousand New Leones (NLe 2,000.00)** and bidders may obtain further information on the bidding document at the address below between 11:00 am to 4:00pm from Mondays to Fridays no-later than seven (7) days prior to the deadline of submission of bids. The method of payment will be cash.

Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 29th May, 2023 All bids must be accompanied by:
